

GDPR Information Clause**

According to Article 13, act 1 and 2 of the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/WE (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR"), we inform you that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is Poznan University of Technology (pl. Marii Skłodowskiej-Curie 5, 60-965 Poznań, e-mail: biuro.rektora@put.poznan.pl, phone: +48 61 665 3639).
2. In matters relating to data protection, the Data Protection Officer can be contacted - Piotr Otomański, e-mail: iod@put.poznan.pl.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of conducting the EUNICE Start Cup Competition.
4. The recipients of your personal data will be the following entities:
 - a. entities that process data on behalf of Poznan University of Technology, these are entities to which we outsource the implementation of various types of services, e.g. IT, AIP employees, people implementing the EUNICE project,
 - b. entities authorised by law,
 - c. entities authorised by the Competition Participant.
5. Your personal data will be stored for a period of 5 years.
6. You have the right to:
 - a. access your personal data,
 - b. rectify your personal data,
 - c. delete your personal data,
 - d. restrict processing of your personal data,
 - e. withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data through - if you have previously given such consent and the processing of data concerning you is based on such consent,
 - f. transfer your personal data,
 - g. object to the processing of your personal data for reasons related to your particular situation in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR. Regardless of the above, you have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the regulations of the GDPR.
7. The provision of your personal data is voluntary but necessary to fulfil the purpose referred to in act 3. Their refusal is equivalent to the impossibility of taking the relevant actions in relation to the participation in the EUNICE Start Cup Competition.
8. Your personal data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area/to an international organisation. Your personal data will not be processed by automated means (including profiling) in such a way that any decisions could be made as a result of such automated processing, other legal effects would be produced or your rights would otherwise be significantly affected.
